Present Mayor Neal, Aldermen Roberts, Thurman, DeBerry, Wilson & White, Jno Nichols, Marshall.

The Mayor stated that he had called the Board together for the purpose of adopting suitable resolution in relation to the death of our Brother Alderman Alfred Stevens.

On motion Aldermen DeBerry & White were appointed a committee to draft said resolutions.

On motion the Mayor was added to the committee.

Whereupon the Board adjourned.
